Field Trips on the Farm

At CFT we love our Raley's Fields Trips on the Farm program. Although we are surrounded by farmland, most students have no understanding of how their food grows. In partnership with Raley's, and with assistance from California Ag in the Classroom and local farms, CFT is working to close this learning gap. Helping kids understand and appreciate where their food comes from is important for the future of our food supply. Our goal is to educate children about agriculture, to help them gain an appreciation for the precious, limited land resources we have in California.
